ORDER

As Chandigarh Administration has decided to ensure safety of non-vaccinated Adult Persons and In pursuance of the Order No. H-III(5)/2021/19029 dated 24.12.2021 issued by Chairperson issued by the Adviser to the Administrator-cum-Chairperson, State Executive Committee of State Disaster Management Authority, UT, Chandigarh(Copy Enclosed).

All the concerned officials to strictly enforce the following measures w.e.f. 31.12.2021:-

1. The staff/employees fully vaccinated (Second Dose) or those who are not due for second dose as per Health Protocol should only be allowed to enter/deployed on duties in to the Offices, Command Control Center, Depots and ISBTs.
2. The commuters/Passengers who are fully vaccinated (Second Dose) or those who are not due for second dose as per Health Protocol should only be allowed to enter in to the Buses and ISBTs.
3. Regular Public Announcements should be made at both ISBTs conveying the message that all the adult persons should get themselves vaccinated. In case any adult person(s) is/are found with above violation, he/she will be imposed a fine of Rs 500. Non-payments of such fine by the violator will attract proceedings under section 188 of Indian Penal Code.
4. In case any adult person(s) is found with above violation, he/she will be imposed on the spot fine of Rs 500 by concerned Inspectors deputed at ISBTs/Buses.

Further it is hereby directed that following means may be considered for verifying the vaccination status (in case of COVISHIELD beneficiary will be eligible for second dose after 84 days from first dose of COVAXIN, beneficiary will be eligible for second dose from first dose):

1. Downloaded certificates of 2nd dose(Hard/Soft copies)
2. 1st dose certificate to check if 2nd dose is due or not.
3. Person not having smart phones, Text messages sent via COWIN portal may be considered fro successful vaccination.
4. Aarogya Setu App to check vaccination status.



In Order to ensure strict compliance of Orders, the following Nodal Officers are designated:-

S. No.	Designation	Remarks
1.	Station Supervisor (H)	He will ensure the strict compliance of above said orders in the buses with the help of Route Inspectors and Flying Squad Inspectors.
2.	Station Supervisor, ISBT 17 and 43	He will depute adequate number of security guards at entry points at ISBTs. He will also ensure the strict compliance of above said orders at ISBTs with the help of Inspectors deputed at Bus Stand.
3.	Central Flying Squad Inspectors	They will also ensure the strict compliance of above said orders in buses.
3.	Duty Incharges, Depot 1,2,3 & 4	They will ensure the compliance for the crew staff.
4.	Works Manager, Depot 1,2,3,4	They will ensure the compliance for the rest of staff of Depot.
5.	Superintendentat(H)	He will ensure the compliance for office staff of CTU and CCBSS.

All the Nodal Officers to submit daily compliance report for the same. Both the General Managers to ensure the strict compliance in this regard.

ORDER

No.13180-HIII(5)/2021/19029
Chandigarh, dated the 24/12/2021

As all are aware that COVID-19 Pandemic has posed a huge challenge to the community and affected each and every individual adversely. Large numbers of beneficiaries are due and overdue since long for 2nd dose of COVID-19 Vaccination. Further, new variants of COVID are emerging frequently and recently Omicron cases are showing increasing trend in our country. Looking into current scenario steps need to be taken for increasing coverage of vaccination to mitigate spread of Corona Virus.

The COVID vaccination has been demonstrated to be effective against SARS-CoV2 Variants of concern in reducing mortality, morbidity and mortality. It is therefore, of paramount importance to fully vaccinate the remaining population. Considering emergent issues especially because of the new variant of concern 'OMICRON' of COVID-19, the persons who are not fully vaccinated are required to take more precautions. Accordingly, all those adult persons who have not yet taken both the doses of COVID vaccination should remain at their residences and should not visit any of the Public Places/Market/function/Public Transport/Religious Places etc.

Now the Chandigarh Administration has decided that to ensure safety of non-vaccinated Adult Persons, the following should be strictly enforced from 01.01.2022 in entire UT Chandigarh:-

- 1) In public places with large gatherings like Sabzi Mandi, Grain Markets, Public Transport, Parks religious places Malls, shopping complexes, Haats, Local Market and other similar places only fully vaccinated (second Dose) adult persons or those who are not due for second dose as per health protocol are to be allowed. In case any adult person(s) are found of above violations, they would be imposed a fine of Rs.500/-. Non-payment of the fine by the violator will attract proceedings under Section 188 of IPC. Every Officer designated below shall be responsible for enforcing of these directions:-
 - i) Tehsildar and Naib-Tehsildar;
 - ii) Additional/ Joint Commissioners, Municipal Corporation;
 - iii) Medical Officer of health, Municipal Corporation;
 - iv) Medical Officers as designated by the Director Health & Family Welfare, UT Chandigarh;
 - v) Station House Officers;
 - vi) Any other Officer/ Official specifically designated by the Deputy Commissioner, Chandigarh from time to time.

- 2) All Government/Board/Corporation offices located in Chandigarh to allow only fully vaccinated (second Dose) Adult Persons (including their employees) or those who are not due for second dose as per health protocol.
- 3) Hotels, Bars, Restaurants, Mall, Shopping Complexes, Cinema Halls, Gym and Fitness Centers to allow only fully vaccinated (second Dose) Adult Persons (including their employees) or those who are not due for second dose as per health protocol.
- 4) Both Private and Government Sector Banks to allow only fully vaccinated (second Dose) Adult Persons (including their employees) or those who are not due for second dose as per health protocol. Instruction to these banks may be given, accordingly.

Following means may be considered for verifying the vaccination status (in case of COVISHEID beneficiary will be eligible for second dose after 84 days from first dose and in case of COVAXIN, beneficiary will be eligible for second dose after 28 days from first dose):

- i. Downloaded certificates of 2nd dose (Hard/ Soft Copies)
- ii. 1st dose certificate to check if 2nd dose is due or not.
- iii. Person not having smart phones, Text message sent via COWIN portal (NHPSMS) may be considered for successful vaccination.
- iv. Arogya setu app to check vaccination status.

Adequate publicity of all above mentioned measures to be done by Deputy Commissioner, Chandigarh to ensure awareness among general public regarding COVID-19 Vaccination.

Vaccination teams where and whenever demanded by office in charges for on the spot vaccination or for regular vaccination camps at places of gathering would be provided by the Health Department, Chandigarh.

In order to contain the spread of Corona Virus infection Deputy Commissioner, UT Chandigarh to ensure compliance to above mentioned steps 1st January, 2022 onwards.
