ORDER

Whereas Sh. Bahadur Singh, Driver No. 341, of this office was Charge Sheeted vide this office Memo No. 6571/ECD/G-2/CTU/2020 dated 17.07.2020, for the following charges:-

"On 13.02.2020 Sh. Supinder Singh, duty Inspector Depot- II has submitted an absent report on 11.02.2020 wherein Sh. Bahadur Singh, Driver No. 341 was on earned leave w.e.f. 18.12.2019 to 10.02.2020. The Duty section-II has tried to call him many times but he did not reply moreover the above said official did not send any application for leave or message to the Duty section-II till date Thus. He is continuously absent from his duty without any information from 11.02.2020 to till date which amounts to grave misconduct on his part. He was issued Charge sheet vide memo No. 6571/ECD/G-2/CTU/2020 dated 17.07.2020, directing him to furnish his reply within 15 days for remaining willfully absent from duty w.e.f 11.02.2020 onwards. But he failed to do so. He was called for personal hearing by the law officer on 03.08.2021, 13.08.2021 and 01.10.2021 but he did not appear In this way, Sh. Bahadur Singh, Driver No. 341 has misconducted himself for remaining absent from duty unauthorized/willfully since 11.02.2020 onwards without any leave application, information which attracts for grave misconduct on his part.

By doing, so, the said Sh. Bahadur Singh, Driver No. 341 has acted in a manner unbecoming of a Govt. Servant violating the provisions of Rule 3 of the Govt. Employees (Conduct) Rules, 1966 calling for disciplinary action against him for not performing his duty as directed and for remaining willfully absent from duty w.e.f 11.02.2020 without any leave. information which amounts to grave misconduct on his part.

And whereas, Sh. Bahadur Singh, Driver No. 341 failed to submit reply to the charge sheet. In order to meet the end of justice the Competent Authority ordered to conduct regular departmental inquiry by appointing an inquiry officer. The Inquiry Officer afforded proper and reasonable opportunity to defend his case but he failed to appear before the inquiry officer. The inquiry Officer proceeded Ex-parte against the delinquent official Sh. Bahadur Singh, Driver No. 341 and held that the charges leveled against Sh. Bahadur Singh, Driver No. 341 vide memo No. 390/LO(H)/CTU/2022 dated 13.04.2022 stand proved Ex Parte. A copy of the inquiry report was sent to make representation, if any, to Sh. Bahadur Singh, Driver No. 341 vide memo No. 7157/ECD/G-II/CTU/2022 dated 02.05.2022 through registered Post at his address available in the record but both registered post received back undelivered in the office with remarks of Postal Authority that "PRAPAT KARTA VIDESH GAYA HOI HAI".

And whereas, Sh. Bahadur Singh, Driver No. 341 was called for personal hearing on 29.06.2020 at 3.30 P.M. but he neither appeared for personal hearing nor sent any information to this office. However, in order to meet the end of justice and gave him another opportunity, he was called through Public Notice published in three leading news papers to appear before the undersigned on 29.06.2022 at 3.00 P.M., for personal hearing, failing which it shall be presumed that he has nothing to say in this regard and ex-parte decision will be taken without any further notice, but neither he appeared in person before the undersigned on 29.06.2022 nor sent any information to this office and did not avail this opportunity also. Since, he is willfully absenting from duty w.e.f 11.02.2020 to onwards, it is evident that he is not interested in the job.

And Whereas, Sh.Bahadur Singh, Driver No. 341 is willfully absenting from duty and not responding to the communication of this office. The undersigned has gone through the inquiry report and facts of the case. The Inquiry officer afforded proper and reasonable opportunity to Sh.Bahadur Singh, Driver No. 341 but he failed to avail the same. He also failed to avail the opportunity for personal hearing. The undersigned fully agree with the finding of inquiry officer holds that the charges leveled against Sh.Bahadur Singh, Driver No. 341 stands proved. Therefore, the undersigned is fully convinced that Sh. Bahadur Singh, Driver No. 341 is not a fit person to be retained in service.

Now, therefore, the undersigned, in exercise of the powers conferred under the Punjab Civil Services (Punishment & Appeal) Rules 1970 do hereby order to dismiss Sh.Bahadur Singh, Driver No. 341 from service with immediate effect.
