At the outset, DSP/Traffic (R&D) welcomed all the members in the 10<sup>th</sup> meeting of District Road Safety Committee. Thereafter, action taken on the agenda points of the last meeting held on 27.12.2023 was presented to the Committee and the current status report by concerned departments was given as under:-

SSP/Traffic asked DSP/Traffic (Admin) to conduct a joint survey in this regard and put up proposal accordingly.

The Chairman asked DSP/Traffic (Admin) and representative of CE/UT to expedite the same and submit ATR in the next meeting of DRSC.

# (Action by DSP/Tr (Admn) & CE/UT)

 Progress on rectification work of black spots in U.T Chandigarh (Active Black Spots).

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Issues of construction of Table-Tops at Black Spots which have been constructed so far and yet to be constructed and deviations from IRC Code 103.

The representative of CE/UT informed that most of the required road furniture regarding rectification of black spots has been completed which includes construction of table tops, installation of cautionary signage, markings and cat eyes etc.

DSP/Traffic (R&D) apprised that the road furniture i.e. cat eye study and cautionary signage are not installed properly at the following black spots locations:-

- i. Sector 46/47-48/49
- ii. Sector 44/45/49/50
- iii. Sector 45-46/49/50

DSP/Traffic (R&D) apprised as per the latest directions of MoRTH, new Accident Prone Area signboard needs to be installed on all the Accident Prone Locations as per IRC Code. A letter in this regard has already been sent to CE/UT and CE/MCC for further necessary action in this matter.

The Chairman asked the representative of CE/UT & CE/MCC to expedite the same and submit ATR in the next meeting of DRSC.

## (Action by CE/UT & CE/MCC)

The representative of CA/UT informed that Heritage Committee has accorded the approval regarding pick and drop location identified on slow carriageways

 Proposal regarding earmarking of Pick and Drop Points for Auto Rickshaws as per Bus Queue Shelters in the City.

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adjoining Madhya Marg.

The Chairman pointed out that why this matter of pick and drop locations on slow carriageways adjoining Madhya Marg was taken up in the Sub Committee of CHCC. Further, the Chairman also pointed out that the CA/UT may apprise as to whether Right of Way (RoW) of the carriageways (roads) are under Heritage and any road work being carried out in RoW is also covered under Heritage?

He further pointed out that why there was a need to examine this matter in the Sub Committee of CHCC as the work gets delayed unnecessarily. He further pointed out that this matter of providing pick and drop location for auto rickshaws in the slow carriageways (RoW of carriageways) is causing any effect on the facade of the existing buildings or concealing the look of the existing buildings.

The Chairman asked the representative of CA/UT to intimate which RoW of carriageways and the works to be undertaken in the RoWs of carriageways are covered under Heritage which needs to be referred to the Heritage Committee for approval.

He asked the representative of CA/UT to apprise the same in the next meeting of DRSC.

The representative of CA/UT informed that site visit was conducted in this regard on 17.1,2024 wherein it was decided that existing auto stand may be used for auto rickshaw and e-rickshaw and same passage may be used for entry and exit as sufficient space is available. DSP/Traffic (R&D) apprised that this site has been approved as auto rickshaw stand and there is requirement of signages.

He further apprised that it has been made mandatory for the agencies to download the "Cell Before U Big" App and do any type of digging only after prior intimation through CBuD App. It has also made mandatory to use the App and report the location of road cut/excavation on the CBuD App before commencing excavation/road cut.

The representative of CE/MCC Informed that whatsapp group has been created having 79 officials of CE/MC and CE/UT where the information regarding digging/laying of optical fibers is shared

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prior to the execution of the work.

DSP/Traffic (Admn) pointed out that the agencies carried out various engineering works are not placing cautionary signages about the road closure, work in progress, diversion etc. as well as no proper barricading is being done which is dangerous for the road users.

The Chairman asked the representative of CE/UT and CE/MCC to ensure proper cross checking of the measures being undertaken by the vender at the time of executing these works as well as upon the completion of these works that no un-patched work area is left over at the work site.

The Chairman asked the representative of CE/UT and CE/MCC to do the needful and apprise ATR in the next meeting.

The chairman asked the representative of CE/MCC and CE/UT to look into the matter

DSP/Traffic (R&D) pointed out that DSP/Traffic (R&D) informed that no contractors are not deploying proper proper warning signages pertaining to signages i.e. "man at work, drive-slow, Diversion, Road Closed etc" are installed at the work diversion etc at the construction locations which are required for the works being carried out on road or adjoining area of road as debris i.e. sand, bricks, etc are lying on the concerned officer of engineering main carriageway which are departments that such signages are placed by the Contractor to whom the resulting into any untoward incident.
